


Once considered a niche market, socially responsible investments now account for more than \$600 billion, or over 20 per cent<sup>1</sup>, of the investable assets in Canada. This can be attributed to SRI's ability to not only make a difference in the world, but to also generate returns in line with traditional investments while controlling risk. In fact, over the last 10 years, SRI investments, as measured by the Jantzi Social Index<sup>®</sup>, performed as well or better than traditional investments a majority of the time<sup>2</sup>.

In other words, by choosing socially responsible investments you are not sacrificing financial returns. You are just choosing to do well while you are doing good.

- Upholding respect for the basic human rights of all people to live free of fear, violence, intimidation and discrimination








# How SRI works

Socially responsible investing is the process of making investment decisions using traditional financial analysis while also evaluating performance on environmental, social and governance factors.



The OceanRock approach to SRI involves three core elements:

#### Screening

Selecting responsible, well-performing companies to invest in, using some of the most comprehensive screening criteria.

#### Shareholder Engagement

Working directly with the companies we invest in to effect positive, measurable change towards improved environmental, social and governance practices.

#### **Community Development Investments (CDI)**

Impacting people and the environment by investing in programs that earn financial returns while achieving positive and lasting social and/or environmental impacts.

The best companies to invest in, we believe, are committed to strong environmental, social and governance performance. They are more efficient, more productive, more respected, and better able to mitigate risks for investors.



## Screening — Invest in leaders

On top of financial performance criteria, OceanRock employs screening to make sure that best-in-sector companies with strong performance in the areas of environmental, social and governance (ESG) are held in our funds and portfolios.

We have some of the most comprehensive screens in place. Often, SRI managers only use negative screening to exclude companies from their funds and portfolios. OceanRock also employs positive screening, which is a proactive process designed to screen in companies that demonstrate leadership in key ESG areas.

## Shareholder Engagement — Influence change

Even best-in-sector companies aren't perfect. By being invested, we have an opportunity to influence companies within our funds and portfolios to improve their ESG performance, essentially giving investors a voice at the boardroom table. Our ongoing shareholder engagement efforts have influenced meaningful change in many companies, including eliminating toxins in personal care products, strengthening the businesses of small-scale coffee farmers and earning shareholders a "say on pay."

#### Community Development Investments — Make an impact

Community Development Investments (CDI) are unique to Meritas SRI Funds. We are the only national investment fund family in Canada that allocates up to two per cent of each fund to these investments. We work with organizations that finance small local business institutions, similar to credit unions which, in turn, use the financing to provide micro-loans to entrepreneurial people living in impoverished communities.
